

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION SOCCER FOR KIDS ORGANIZATION

1. The name of the existing unincorporated association is SOCCERFORKIDS.ORG. The name of the Nonprofit Corporation is soccerforkids.org.
2. The Corporation is a Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation is not is organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purpose under applicable rule and regulations of Internal Revenue Service Code Section 501© (3).
3. The purpose of this corporation is to (a) foster youth sports competition as a qualified amateur sports organization, (b) develop quality soccer programs which promote fun and a competitive environment for disadvantaged youth, and (c) to promote and support the character building principles of trustworthiness, respect, responsibility, fairness, caring and good citizenship in order to help develop not only quality players but also youth who can show good sportsmanship on and off the playing field. The membership of the corporation is open to all soccer players, coach, trainers, managers, administrators, and officials without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

5. This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of internal Revenue Code Section 501 © (3) or the corresponding provision of any future united States internal Revenue Law.

The Corporation shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers that do not further the purposes of this corporation, and the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 501 © (3) or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under internal Revenue Code Section 170© (2) or the corresponding provision of any United States Internal Revenue Law.

6. Tax – Exempt status:
 - A. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of lobbying or propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except as provided in Internal Revenue Code Section 501(h); this corporation shall not participate or intervene in (including publishing or distribution statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
 - B. All corporate property is irrevocably dedicated to the purposes set forth in Article 3. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any its Directors, Trustees, Officers, Private shareholders or Members, or the individuals.
 - C. On the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts, obligations, and expenses, any amounts left over shall be distributed in accordance with the purpose for the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, the remaining corporate assets shall be distributed to charitable purposes and that is tax exempt under Internal Revenue Code Section 501 ©3.

D. This corporation will not make investments in a manner that would subject it to tax under Internal Revenue Code Section 4944 or under corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.

E. The corporation will not make any taxable expenditure as defined in Internal Revenue Code Section 4954 (d) or in corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.
